COVID-19 Preparedness and Response Plan

Monitoring Symptoms of COVID-19 for Children

When Children Arrive:

- Temperature check (Using no touch thermometer)
 - A child with a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees will be excluded from care until the ***child is fever free for 72 hours without fever reducing medicine***
- Parents will complete the COVID-19 Checklist for symptoms and/or possible exposure
- Volunteers will visually check the children for signs of illness

Monitoring Symptoms of COVID-19 for Volunteers

When Volunteers Arrive:

- Temperature check (Using no touch thermometer)
 - A volunteer with a temperature at or above 100.4 degrees or other symptoms will be sent home
- Volunteers will complete the COVID-19 Checklist for symptoms and/or possible exposure

Social Distancing, Hygiene, Cleaning, and Disinfecting

Social distancing is tricky with young children so here is what we will be doing to ensure the safety of the children in regards to social distancing:

- Children will be in consistent small group centers with volunteers monitoring space as best as possible
- Centers will be disinfected as children rotate and transition
- Seating will be as far apart as possible
- We will be staggering restroom breaks between the older and younger classes
- Common spaces shared by all children will be cleaned before and after service
- We will continue with our typical hand washing after restroom breaks encouraging volunteers and children to wash for 20 seconds
- Cloth toys and any toys that are not easy to clean have been removed from the classes
- Drinking fountains will be closed until further notice

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE)

Masks will be required for all volunteers and children age 4 and up through the duration of service. Masks will be provided to those who need them.

Drop Off and Pick Up

- A volunteer will take the child's temperature with a no touch thermometer as the parent completes our COVID-19 questionnaire.
- Children will sanitize their hands with provided hand sanitizer.
- Once the child is checked in, a volunteer will take the child to their classroom and have them remove their shoes before entering the classroom.
- If you, as a parent, must enter the kid's program for any reason you will be required to wear a mask.
- At the end of service, volunteers will meet parents at the classroom doors with their child/children. You must present your child/children's identification sticker.
- We also ask that you practice social distancing when dropping off and picking up your child.

Visitors

Non-essential visitors and volunteers will not be allowed in the classrooms until further notice.
